

## WITNEY PROJECTILE RANGE COVID 19 Regulations

## The following are **MANDATORY** conditions governing use of this Range:

1) All clubs/user groups <u>must conduct their own risk assessment</u>, as per current Government, National Rifle Association (NRA) and National Small-bore Rifle Association (NSRA) guidelines.

2) All clubs / user groups must compile their own set of Covid-safe rules, and nominate a supervisory club official / Range Officer to ensure that range use complies with them.

3) All clubs / user groups **must clean and sanitize surfaces, door handles, shooting benches, etc.** both **prior to, and at the end of their period of use**.

4) All clubs / user groups must provide hand sanitizer and disposable hand towels for their members use, and PPE and additional cleaning materials for their nominated official(s)/Range Officer(s).

5) <u>All clubs / user groups must maintain a COVID 19 'Track and Trace' Register</u>. This may be combined with the Range Register but <u>must</u> include:

- a) Full Name and Contact Details;
- b) Time of Entry (into the facility);
- c) Time of Exit (from the facility);
- d) Space for notes (i.e. legal / medical exemption from face covering).

6) <u>'Step 2 100sqft Rule' applies to the entire Range Complex</u> Applies to Club Room & Range. This means a MAXIMUM of :

- I x nominated Official / Range Officer (responsible for access control, completion of 'Trackand-Trace' Register, equipment sanitation, compliance, etc.);
- Maximum of 5 others (i.e. Full members, or Probationers + coaches), at any one time;
- Groups of users <u>must not mix</u> (changeover outside the facility).
- 7) All individuals must wear a face covering when inside this facility, unless legally/medically exempt (proof required).
- 8) **During Firing**. Use range EXTRACTION fans <u>only</u> (NOT circulatory); open doors where possible.
- 9) Users **may not share their firearms, equipment or ammunition**, unless shooting with a member of their own household (**equipment must be securely bagged between firing details**).
- 10) Only authorised Range Officers, firers, coaches/instructors, and Safeguarding personnel may enter the facility when the range is in use. <u>NO VISITORS</u> Updated to reflect UK Government Roadmap Step 2 April 2021



## COVID 19 - SUPPLEMENTARY NOTE to CLUBS / USER GROUPS

All users <u>MUST</u> comply with <u>WITNEY PROJECTILE RANGE - COVID 19 Regulations</u> Issued separately to all users, and displayed prominently at the Range.

The following suggestions have been made to us, and might assist range users:

- 1) **Pre-Booked Shooting 'Slots':** Clubs / User Groups might consider the temporary introduction of a system of timed 'slots', possibly along the following lines:
  - a) Have a **fixed time 'slot** 'for each 'group' (35min 1 hour?), ensuring that time is allowed for changeover (3-5min?);
  - b) All places within these 'slots' <u>booked in advance</u> (no casual attendance), and limited to one place in one 'slot' per session to prevent cross-contamination and allow fair distribution.
  - c) Allow a **maximum of 5 persons** (in addition to the Range Officer / supervising official) shooters per 'slot'. This might be less if accommodating users with particular vulnerabilities;
  - d) Users wait in the carpark for their slot (late arrivals may have to lose their slot);
  - e) Allow entry only after previous group has exited the range;
  - f) Maintain 'Social Distancing' outside the range complex, or wear a face-covering.
- 2) **Shooting Equipment / Firearms**. Each shooter should be instructed to arrive at the range self-contained, bringing all equipment and ammunition they intend to use with them.
  - a) <u>Club Firearms.</u> Clubs / User Groups might choose to allow use of a club firearm by members without their own firearm during their timed 'slot'.
     <u>Firearm Useage.</u> Clubs / User Groups must judge how many users they can accommodate during each session, bearing in mind that, to prevent cross-infection, club firearms should be deep cleaned<sup>1</sup> before and after each user so may choose to impose a strict limit (for practical reasons this may be as low as 1 use per session).
- Probationary Members and Non-FAC Holders. If clubs choose to allow these users access to club equipment / firearms, all items must be sanitized/cleaned between users (provision should be made / time allowed to do this).
  - a) <u>Club-Supplied Ammunition</u>. Clubs may feel it sensible to limit purchase of clubsupplied ammunition to these User Groups only;
  - b) <u>Sanitised Containers</u>. Clubs / User Groups may consider ammunition issue in sanitised bags/containers, with clear instructions that all ammunition is expended during the session (i.e. no contaminated returns requiring storage for future use).
